New SGI Programs to Improve Hometown Traffic Safety

SGI has introduced **two new programs** that could have a positive impact on traffic safety in your hometown.

Through the new **Provincial Traffic Safety Fund Grant** program, individuals representing municipalities, Indigenous lands/territories, and law enforcement can apply for a grant to undertake traffic safety initiatives in their communities. Grants of up to **\$100,000 per initiative** are available.

If speeding is an issue in your community, you can now apply to bring in **photo speed enforcement (PSE)** technology. New PSE technology locations will be selected by the PSE Committee. Locations that may be eligible include high-risk, high-collision, and high-volume pedestrian areas.

The selection committee will meet in late spring 2019 with presentation events in fall of 2019.

[Nomination forms](#) for the medal can be found online.

- Nominations must be received within one year of retirement or departure from an eligible position.
- Nominations must be signed by the heads of eligible agencies or by the chair of government approved agency selection committee (chief of police, fire chief, warden, etc.)
- For Canadian Forces and RCMP personnel, the Commanding Officer (CO) must sign the nomination form. For COs, it must be signed by your immediate supervisor.
- For nominations of heads of eligible agencies (fire chief, chief of police), your mayor, town administrator, or reeve must sign the nomination form.
- For uniformed government workers, the nomination form must be signed by an Assistant Deputy Minister or Deputy Minister.
