RCMP Services in Saskatchewan

- Provincial Police Service Agreement
 - \$224 million (2014-15)
 - Government of Saskatchewan pays 70%
 - Government of Canada pays 30%
- First Nations Policing Program
 - \$21.4 million (2014-15)
 - Government of Canada 52%
 - Government of Saskatchewan 48%
- Municipal Police Service Agreements (MPSA)
 - Municipal Governments 70% to 90%
 - Government of Canada 30% to 10%



Cost per RCMP Member

General Duty Policing Cost Breakdown (2016-17)

Constable Salary: \$82,108

Non-Salary Costs: \$40,000
 Includes informatics, unit budgets, training, reallocation, and other O&M.

Capital: \$8,000

Indirect Costs: \$46,820

Div Admin, El, Pension, CPP, Recruiting, Cadet Training Program, Cadet Training Program, Public Complaints Commission, Enhanced Reporting and Accountability, Legal Services.

Total: \$176,928



RCMP General Duty in SK

- There are <u>874</u> RCMP General Duty positions in Saskatchewan:
 - 626 PPSA positions
 - 124 positions service First Nation communities
 - 124 positions service municipalities with Municipal Police Service Agreements.



Cost of Rural Policing

- RMs and Small Urban Municipalities
 - Approximately \$70 million in 2014-15 to support general duty policing in RMs and small urban municipalities with populations below 5,000.
 - The Ministry pays 76% of these costs.
 - RMs and small urban municipalities have benefits of receiving FNPP members and MPSA members when PPSA members cannot respond to calls for service or back-up is required.
