Board members are responsible for certifying water and wastewater operators within the province of Saskatchewan. Board members also manage the operation of the Board, its finances, its office and its Office Administrator. Currently the Board is financially self-sufficient based on application and renewal fees.

There are about six meetings per year in Regina, with members receiving a per diem and expenses. Board members are appointed annually by the Minister of Environment.

Community Airport Partnerships program seeks applicants

The Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure (MHI) is once again offering the Community Airport Partnership (CAP) Program to eligible airports in southern Saskatchewan.

CAP was introduced in 2007 and will be in its sixth year of implementation. Eligible community airports may apply for an infrastructure grant. If recommended for approval by a review panel of aviation experts, the project is cost shared 50/50 between the community and MHI to a maximum MHI contribution of \$275,000.
