Notes From the Board Meeting

It's been a busy few months since the last SUMA Board meeting, and we gathered again in Regina last week. At this meeting, we had two **alternates at the Board table**: Councillor Gerald Roy representing the Northern Region in place of Bruce Fidler, and Councillor Eric Olason representing the City of Saskatoon in place of Councillor Tiffany Paulsen.

- The meeting began with a visit from **Minister of Government Relations Jim Reiter**. We discussed the new Building Canada Fund, municipal asset management, and the work SUMA is doing with the Saskatchewan Parks and Recreation Association on regional recreation collaboration.
- We approved a [policy statement](#) on **rail safety**.
- The Board also approved the **delivery of legal services** to members through short consultations, legal resources available online, and through SUMA publications, and workshops/sessions on legal issues affecting urban governments. These services will be available thanks to our Policy and Legal Advisor Steven Dribnenki.
- Planning is underway for an **advocacy day** at the Legislature during the spring sitting.
- We heard a preliminary report on proposed **changes to the SUMA resolution process**. More details should be available after the June Board meeting.
- Staff provided updates on the Recycling Infrastructure Grant Program, the Town Urban Highway Program and the Urban Highway Connector Program.
- The **Convention Planning Committee Chair** baton was passed from Councillor Randy Goulden to Councillor Ted Zurakowski; Councillor Dawn Luhning was named Vice-Chair. Thanks to all who responded to
