CMHC Seed Funding Program – Deadline: Open year-round

CMHC's Seed Funding Program offers financial assistance to housing proponents who are in the early stages of developing an affordable housing project. Eligible projects include housing market studies, development of a business plan, exploration of funding sources, preliminary financial viability analysis, environmental site assessment, and preliminary design of the housing project. Invest Canada – Community Initiatives – Deadline: Fall of 2010

The Federal Department of Foreign Affairs and International Trade's Invest Canada-Community Initiatives (ICCI) is designed to help Canadian communities attract, retain and expand foreign direct investment. ICCI supports non-profit and public-private partnerships at the local community level. Non-repayable contributions range from \$3,000 to \$300,000, and agreements are made for a one-year period, from January 1 to December 31.
