Mosquito Control Program - Deadline: July 15

The Government of Saskatchewan is providing \$1.1 million in one-time funding for mosquito control because of this year's weather conditions. The program will provide communities who make application with a maximum grant of \$1.10 per capita (based on 2006 census figures) for activities such as planning, larval site identification and mapping, surveillance, training and mosquito control activities such as source reduction, public education and larviciding.
