Remember – the SIGI Deadline is September 30!

The Saskatchewan Infrastructure Growth Initiative (SIGI) Program provides municipalities with interest rate subsidies for five years on \$300 million of municipal borrowing. The deadline to submit applications for the 2011-12 fiscal year is Sept. 30. The application form and guide are available by clicking here.

Lower deductibles, more funding available: *improvements to Provincial Disaster Assistance Program (PDAP)*

With a summer of unprecedented weather damage, Saskatchewan residents have incurred major losses from flooding, tornadoes, plow winds and severe storms. The provincial government recently announced improvements to the PDAP including a reduction for private claimants' deductibles from 20% to 5% and increases to the maximum amount of financial assistance available to individuals, small businesses, non-profits, boards and primary agricultural enterprises. Red Cross toll-free information & recovery line

The Red Cross has set up a province wide toll-free number to reach out to people affected by severe weather, making Red Cross services more accessible to the most vulnerable whose basic needs may still be unmet. The number, 1-888-953-3463 is manned Monday to Friday from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m., and Saturday noon to 5 p.m.; a message may be left 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and a Red Cross worker will return your call. The line will be open until Aug. 29, 2010. The number is free to call and confidential. Red Cross assistance is provided at no cost to the recipient and is coordinated with governments, insurance and other organizations to ensure needs are met without duplication. The Saskatchewan Infrastructure Growth Initiative (SIGI) – Deadline: September 30, 2010

This program) is designed to assist municipalities in developing infrastructure to meet the demand associated with servicing lots for new residential, commercial and industrial construction. It provides municipalities with interest rate subsidies for up to five years on \$300 million of municipal borrowing. The borrowing is spread over four years (2008-09 to 2011-12) at \$75 million per year. The initiative is a key component of the government's growth agenda.
