## **Grant of the Week:**

### **Creative Partnerships Program**

Creative Partnerships gives communities, businesses, schools and other organizations a range of opportunities to partner with artists and tap the creativity of the province. Intended to foster innovative opportunities to benefit the people of Saskatchewan, this grant supports artists-in-the-community experiences. The program provides for grant support through two components: the Partnership Explorations Program and the Partnership Innovations Program.

Partnership Explorations grants assist communities that wish to explore opportunities for arts and cultural development in partnership with a professional artist in any discipline. A Partnership Explorations grant is a planning grant. Success with an Explorations grant may lead to an application for a Partnership

Innovations grant which replaces the former Artist in Residence Grant Program. However that is just one opportunity that may be deemed beneficial to a community in its development planning.

Deadline: The application deadline for the Innovations program is May 15 and the deadline for the Explorations program is November 15, 2010.
