FCM says federal government responding to stimulus deadline concerns

Last week, the FCM appeared before the House of Commons Infrastructure and Transportation Committee to discuss the March 31 stimulus deadline. From the start, FCM has urged the federal government – one stimulus partner to another – that it had to show flexibility on the deadline. In this most recent meeting with the committee, FCM reiterated that municipalities have been working flat out to meet the deadline – and that most projects are on or ahead of schedule. They said that where communities have worked hard and played by the rules, our federal, provincial and territorial partners had to be supportive. The FCM recently reported that it is pleased to report the federal government has started responding to these concerns. Finance Minister Jim Flaherty has said the government would treat municipalities fairly and reasonably -- a big step in the right direction. FCM will continue to urge our stimulus partners to show flexibility on the deadline. FCM seeking nominations for Sustainable Communities Awards

Is your municipality a leader in housing regulations? Does an initiative in your community merit national recognition? The 2011 FCM Sustainable Community Awards celebrate excellence in sustainable community development by highlighting the best municipal initiatives that link environmental, social and economic goals. If your community has made regulatory changes to improve housing affordability and housing options, you may be eligible for an award in the residential development category. Eligible initiatives include the development of or changes to municipal policies and bylaws, building codes, development standards, renovation guidelines and approval procedures that help reduce the cost of housing or increase housing options.

Awards will also be granted in eight categories: brownfields, buildings, energy, planning, residential development, transportation, waste and water.

Grant of the Week:

Family Violence Initiative (Department of Justice Canada)

The Family Violence Initiative supports the development, implementation, testing and assessment of models, strategies and tools to improve the criminal justice system's response to family violence. It also supports projects that raise public awareness of the issue and encourage public involvement in responding to family violence. The objective is to prevent and reduce the occurrence of family violence in Canada.

Funding may be available to organizations that want to conduct pilot projects to develop, test and assess models, strategies and tools to improve the criminal justice system's response to family violence. Funding may also be provided to support Public Legal Education and Information (PLEI) projects to promote public access to family violence information, promote public awareness of the factors contributing to family violence, and advance public involvement in the responses to family violence. Note: All projects must be short term and innovative. \$10,000 - \$50,000 per project is available. Projects must also meet the funding criteria established for the Department's Justice Partnership and Innovation Fund.

<u>Deadline</u>: Anytime during the year. Decisions on funding may take up to 12 weeks after receipt of the completed application.
