# Kick-Start Your Brownfield Project with a Green Municipal Fund Loan

The Green Municipal Fund (GMF) of the Federation of Canadian Municipalities offers loans for brownfield remediation projects at rates far lower than any municipal government can get on the market. GMF also provides grants for brownfield action plans, such as community improvement plans (CIPs); grants for site testing and remediation plans, including Phase II environmental site assessments; remedial action plans and risk assessments; and educational and training resources.
