Second Intake for Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program

We all know infrastructure dollars are few and far between, so SUMA wants to highlight the second round of intake on this program, as part of the 150th anniversary of Confederation. I encourage all of Saskatchewan's urban governments to consider what projects in your communities might qualify for this program.

Once again, the timelines on this program are tight. Applications in Western Canada will be accepted from **Tuesday, May 24** until **Wednesday, June 22** at:

- 1:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time;
- 2:00 p.m. Mountain Standard Time; and
- 3:00 p.m. Central Standard Time (most of the province is currently observing this time).

There is an additional **\$46.2 million** in funding available through Western Economic Diversification Canada (WD) for the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program. These dollars are for projects aiming to **rehabilitate existing community infrastructure** in Western Canada. Priority will be given to:

- recreational facilities;
- projects that support a clean growth economy (i.e., energy efficiency upgrades); and/or
- projects that support indigenous communities and peoples.
